It is therefore very much in the interest of stallion owners and breeders to join forces to produce the horses that the market demands. There are exciting times ahead for our four flat stallions in Rathbarry. BOUTTEMONT had his first foals arrive in early spring and he seems to have passed on all his strength, quality and athleticism to his progeny. He ticks a lot of boxes for Irish commercial breeders, being the fastest ever son of ACCLAMATION to retire to stud as well as an extremely precocious and good-looking horse, standing at a very affordable fee.

KODI BEARS' ability to upgrade his mares was again demonstrated in 2025 with Gr. 2 Gimcrack Stakes winner Lifeplan, being the first group winner of his immediate family. The stallion continues to benefit from this priceless commodity which has increased his commercial appeal and his popularity brought another bumper book of mares in 2025, giving us plenty to look forward to in the future.

The first yearlings by STATE OF REST caused quite a stir in the sales ring with one astute respected agent describing them as "the find of the sales". With prices of 300,000gns, 155,000gns, €155,000, €150,000, €140,000 etc., and purchased by some of the shrewdest judges in the business, they gave an excellent return to the breeders who used his services.

Rathbarry has always strived to provide breeders with stallions who suit a wide range of mares in terms of pedigree, racing performance, conformation and distance aptitude. We think that UNQUESTIONABLE matches up to these criteria. As a racehorse he was brilliant at two, signing off his 2-Y-O campaign by taking the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Santa Anita, Gr. 1 placed twice at three and effective on differing grounds and over distances ranging from 5f to a mile. He embodies all the attributes associated with his much-missed leading sire WOOTTON BASSETT. A \leq 340,000 yearling, UNQUESTIONABLE is supported by a female line of the highest global class as a member of the famous Best In Show family.



Our National Hunt Roster for 2026 at GLENVIEW STUD again features a mix of both proven and young stallions offering National Hunt breeders a rich and diverse source of successful bloodlines. The quality of the mares covered by BLUE BRESIL has increased year on year since he arrived from England in 2020 and this fact combined with bumper books of mares each year would indicate that his progeny will be a force to reckoned with in the future.

JEU ST ELOI'S first two seasons at GLENVIEW STUD in 2024 and 2025 coincided with successive best seasons on the track for his progeny in terms of Winners and Black Type Performers. This was reflected in the quality of mares sent to him which included 105 Black Type Producers/Black Type Performers and Sisters to Gr. 1 winners. Therefore, he should be on all National Hunt breeders radar going forward to capitalise on the quality of the stock he will have to run for him.

OLD PERSIAN'S first crop of 3-year-old stores in 2025 got a great reception at the sales. They were purchased by some of the shrewdest trainers in the business who have all reported that they are good moving, attractive individuals, with great temperament and are natural jumpers. We are looking forward to seeing them perform on the track in 2026.

EAGLES BY DAYS' first crop will be 3-year-olds in 2026 and the feedback from breeders and pinhookers on his first three crops is very complimentary, describing them as quality, correct, athletic individuals with size and strength. In addition, his sire, Sea The Stars, is a growing influence in the national hunt ranks and his dam Missunited proved herself a top-class dual purpose race mare, so this horse deserves serious consideration when deciding on a suitable mating for your mare in the coming season.

We sincerely appreciate breeders support in the past and look forward to a bright 2026 when we can work together to achieve more success on the track and in the sales ring.





UNQUESTIONABLY A STAR...

So highly regarded was Unquestionable as a 2yo at Ballydoyle that he made his **debut in stakes company** in the Listed First Flier Stakes over 5f at the Curragh. By the end of that season he had backed up that reputation and more as a Gr.1 winner who was ranked as **a leader of his generation**.



Unquestionable signed off his 2yo campaign by taking the Gr.1
Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Santa Anita. Sent off favourite for the \$1 million event, he showed an outstanding turn of foot under Ryan Moore to run down the leaders and win going away. It was a typically strong renewal in which seven individual stakes winners finished in behind, among them subsequent dual Gr.1 winner Carson's Run.


Unquestionable was **never out of the frame** for Aidan O'Brien as a 2yo, with his placing in the First Flier Stakes followed by an **impressive maiden success** over 6f at the Curragh. From there, he was beaten just a short head by subsequent Gr.1 winner Bucanero Fuerte in the Gr.2 Railway Stakes, with the pair quickening well clear of the third.

Unquestionable **continued to progress** into the autumn. He was overcome only in the final 100 yards by Rosallion when second in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp, run in **course record time** on good to soft ground, before travelling to California to win the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf back on guick ground.

Brilliant at two, Classic performer at three when fourth in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas and also fourth in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes. Effective on differing grounds and over distances ranging from 5f to a mile, Unquestionable embodies all the attributes associated with his much-missed, leading sire **Wootton Bassett**. The sire line is already taking root if the 2025 season is any indication, when his sons supplied the Gr.1 winners Gezora and Woodshauna.

Unquestionable is supported by a family of the **highest global class** as a member of the famous **Best In Show** family via the Didina branch responsible for **proven Gr.1 sires** Bated Breath and Cityscape.

The Best In Show family is one of the most powerful in the Stud Book as the source of numerous Gr.1 winners, among them champions Almond Eye, El Gran Senor, Peeping Fawn and Rags To Riches. It is also responsible for the breed-shaping sire **Redoute's Choice**, responsible for no fewer than **40 Gr.1 winners**.



THE STORY SO FAR

If the source of exceptional hurdler Constitution Hill and seven other Grade 1 winners isn't safe, no sire is....

His first six crops, the result of his spell in France, contained L'Autonomie, who became a legendary mainstay of Auteuil's Grade 1 hurdling scene, and the likes of Blue Lord, Good Land, Le Prezien, Mick Jazz and Royal Pagaille, all of whom found their fortune after being exported to Britain or Ireland....

His four crops conceived at Yorton Farm, aged between five and eight, have yielded Constitution Hill, his fellow Grade 1 winners Inthepocket and Redemption Day and no end of other smart sorts, such as Choccabloc, Copacabana, Gameofinches, Heads Up, Pembroke, Santos Blue, Wellington Arch and Willmount....

Blue Bresil's first ten crops from his time in France and Britain, only one of which crept over 100 in number and which altogether averaged 65, have produced 460 starters for 194 winners (42 per cent) and 35 black-type performers (7.6 per cent)....

Now that the industry is getting more of a handle on the first Irish-conceived four-year-olds by the sire, they ought to be impressed.

It already features a black-type winner of sorts, thanks to Gordon Elliott's.... Coutach, who was eased down to take the Foxbrook Champion Hurdle (USA) by four-and-a-guarter lengths...

Coutach is one of six winners from around 20 runners under rules among Blue Bresil's fouryear-olds. The other scorers include Blue Waters, who is also trained by Elliott and won for the second time when bolting up in a Listowel maiden hurdle last month, and Samba Train, who has been sent out by Enda Bolger to land bumpers at Limerick and Listowel.

Blue Bresil has also made a more than satisfactory start with his first Irish-conceived representatives in four-year-old point-to-points, which are so important for a sire's profile now.

From Dublin: On M8 South Route from Dublin, Exit Junction 15 signposted for Fermoy & Rathcormac.
At roundabout take 1st exit followed immediately by 1st turn left signposted Castlelyons - Rathbarry Stud (5m/8km) and Glenview Stud (3m/5km).



From Cork: On M8 North Route from Cork, Exit at Junction 15 signposted for Fermoy and take 3rd exit off roundabout, go under flyover bridge and at 2nd roundabout take 1st exit followed immediately by 1st turn left signposted Castlelyons - Rathbarry Stud (5m/8km) and Glenview Stud (3m/5km).

Avoiding the M8 Motorway Bypass

On M8 South Route from Dublin, Exit at Junction 14 signposted for Fermoy, go into Fermoy, on N8 South Route. Take N72 for Waterford/Tallow at lights in the Square. Continue on N72 for (3m/5km) to McDonnells Grain store. Turn right here on to road for Coolagown and continue to T junction and then take left for Rathbarry (1m/1.5km) and right for Glenview (2m/3km).

Alternatively, on the N8 South Route, take N8 for Cork at lights in the Square in Fermoy. At first roundabout take second exit going under flyover bridge. At 2nd roundabout, take 1st exit followed immediately by 1st turn left signposted for Castlelyons - Rathbarry Stud (5m/8km) and Glenview Stud (3m/5km).
